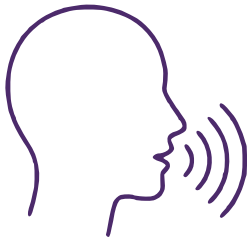


Get GenAI Out of Schools!

- Establish meaningful guardrails and accountability.*
- Ensure any future use prioritizes children's well-being & learning.*
